Mixed berry hobo packs a whollop for dessert!

Ingredients

- 1 pound (3 cups) mixed strawberries and blueberries. strawberries halved or quartered if large
- 1 teaspoon finely grated lemon zest
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 3/4 teaspoon cornstarch
- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter, softened
- 4 12-inch squares of heavyduty aluminum foil

• 4 (1/2-inch-thick) slices of pound cake

Directions

1. Light a grill. In a medium bowl, combine the strawberries zest, lemon juice, sugar, and cornstarch. Spoon 1/4 tablespoon of the butter in the center of each sheet of foil and top with the fruit. Bring 2 sides of fold to form a seam across the fraîche or ice cream. top. Fold the remaining 2 sides

to seal the hobo packs completely.

2. Grill the hobo packs over moderate heat until the fruit is sizzling, about 10 minutes.

Spread the remaining 1 tablespoon of butter on the pound and blueberries with the lemon cake and grill on both sides just until toasted, about 1 minute. Transfer to plates. Open the hobo packs and pour the berries and juices over the pound cake. the foil up over the fruit and Serve with a dollop of crème

Suncreek Villas Pool Safety Rules

The use of the pool amenity center is intended exclusively for the residents of Suncreek Villas and their guests.

- 1. Pool hours: Sunday through Thursday 9:00 am 10:00 pm and Friday and Saturday 9:00 am 11:00 pm. Noise disturbances after these hours should be reported to the police.
- 2. ALL PERSONS SWIM AND USE THE POOL AT THEIR OWN RISK. THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.
- 3. Entry to the pool shall be through the gate only. Climbing over the fence or gate is prohibited. The gate must be closed and locked at all times.
- 4. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- 5. CAUTION: Water in the pool is shallow. NO DIVING ALLOWED. Running, tag games, "cannon-balling" or boisterous play of any kind are not permitted in the pool area.
- 6. Proper swim attire is required. Cut-offs or blue jeans do not meet this requirement. Children who are not potty trained must wear waterproof swim diapers.
- 7. Keep music at a level that does not disturb others using the pool.
- 8. NO GLASS or breakable items in the pool area.
- 9. NO PETS of any nature are allowed in the pool area.
- 10. A Suncreek Villas resident must accompany all guests at all times. No more than 8 guests per residence. Giving out the pool access code to anyone is prohibited.
- 11. Do not swim if there is lightning or thunder.
- 12. Bicycles, roller-skates, skateboards, scooters and motorized or battery operated vehicles are not permitted in the gated pool area.
- 13. Use of floating tubes, rafts and toys must not interfere with the use of the pool by others.
- 14. Use lifesaving equipment only in an emergency. These are not play items and are to be maintained for everyone's safety.
- 15. Report any vandalism or pool concerns to SBB Management Company at 972-960-2800.
- 16. IN CASE OF EMERGENCY CALL 911(emergency phone located outside the front entry gate).

Community Updates and Reminders

On't forget! Quarterly assessments are due July 1st

Please store your trash and recycling containers in your garage and out of public view on non-collection days. Containers should be placed outside the morning of pick-up day.

For those of you who store them in your back yard, please make sure you wash the containers occasionally so they do not cause an odor.

Homeowners are responsible for changing the *exterior light bulbs* as needed. Make a point of stepping outside as soon as it gets dark to check your garage lights. If the bulbs are burned out replace them with a clear candelabra bulb. e need a copy of your condo policy for our files. Please provide evidence of insurance and fax it to 972-991-6642 or e-mail it to Dana or Vanessa.

Homeowners are responsible for basic townhome maintenance. Are the seals of your windows broken or does your front door need re-staining? Take a step back from your home and take a good look at it.

Please do not give out the pool code! Guests must be accompanied by a resident in order to use the pool area. And remember to clean up after using the grill.

Please be careful when driving in the community, especially at the mailboxes. Travel at the posted speed, yield to other drivers, and always stop — a full stop — at all stop signs. It's the LAW.

K eep your garage door closed , even if you are at home, to prevent theft. Be

a good neighbor. If you see suspicious activity in the neighborhood, please contact the Allen Police Department.

If you see the irrigation system running for longer than one hour in any one zone, please contact our office immediately. It is especially important to be "water wise" and conserve water whenever possible. If your call is during normal office hours we can be reached at 972-960-2800. SBB's after hours emergency number is 972-985-8500.

Dog owners must pick up after their pets regardless if the waste is on their own fenced in yard, a neighbor's property, the Association's property, sidewalk or open area. Please use the pet waste station near Apple Hill Drive

and Tarrytown Lane.
